3.4 Statistical concepts and definitions

The statistical survey for the sale of agricultural products has been conducted for a long period of time, since January 1996. This survey is designed to provide statistical data for the sale of agricultural products for national needs. Within the framework of the European statistical system, there is no regulation and practice for the collection of this type of data.

The purpose of this research is to obtain statistical data for the market of agricultural products in the phase of realization of the market surplus of agricultural products. The data is collected for:

Sales of agricultural products from companies and agricultural cooperatives (statistics on sales of agricultural products from own production).

The purpose of the research is to provide statistical data for the sale of agricultural products in the territory where they are produced, expressed in terms of quantity and value. For this purpose, the following data are collected for agricultural products, i.e. for a group of products:

- The quantities of agricultural products sold during the reporting month;
- The value of agricultural products sold during the reporting month; and
- The average values per unit measure of agricultural products sold during the reporting month.

Reporting units are companies that, on the basis of legal regulations, are working in the sale of agricultural products for further realization or processing of those products. These are the following business entities:

- agriculture enterprises,
- agricultural and other cooperatives,
- subcontractor companies in agriculture,

- companies from the food industry that buy or purchase agricultural products for processing or finishing (production of fresh meat and meat processing, grain processing, canning of vegetables and fruits, then dairies, sugar factories, butter factories, starch factories, breweries and etc.)
- enterprises from the area of trade for the supply of agricultural products, then specialized trade enterprises for the sale of alcoholic beverages and goods in the form of seeds, medicinal plants, profitable food, forest crops and similar,

companies that deal with buying as a secondary activity.

Defining statistical variables such

As sales, delivered quantities of agricultural products to enterprises and agricultural cooperatives are considered those quantities of products produced by the enterprises and agricultural cooperatives, as well as the local units within agricultural enterprises engaged in agricultural activity, which during the reporting month were delivered to buyers and other users, regardless of the method of price calculation (sales at market prices and deliveries at internal prices and other forms of internal realization) and the time of payment.

The sold quantities include:

- a) agricultural products ordered from another enterprise and agricultural cooperative in the field of economy (industrial, commercial, agricultural, and others) for processing or further sale as well as outside the economy (to health institutions, the Army, social institutions, and similar) for consumption (all are recorded as sales);
- b) quantities of delivered livestock whose owner is the enterprise or agricultural cooperative, regardless of whether the livestock is raised within the organization or outside it (in another organization or with an individual agricultural producer);
- e) the delivered quantities of agricultural products that are expressed and calculated as internal implementation supply to the own units engaged in the processing or processing of agricultural raw materials from own production (if not invoiced in sales);

18.3 Data collection

The data from the survey is collected using a self-filling method in the statistical questionnaire "Monthly Report on Sales of Agricultural Products from Own Production by Business Entities and Agricultural Cooperatives" (Z.E.TR.G.33). The completed questionnaires are sent by mail to the regional statistical departments no later than the 20th of the following month, where the data and coverage are checked and submitted to the State Statistical Office.

18.4 Data validation

Data verification is carried out in accordance with defined control criteria. Initial data verification is performed at the regional statistics offices upon receipt of the completed questionnaires. Verification is also conducted on the finalized data before their publication.

18.5 Data compilation

Editing: The received data, after checking and possible correction in consultation with the reporting units, are entered on electronic media, through an application with built-in on-line controls.
