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3 Statistical presentation

3.1 Data description

Data on sex, age, place of residence, occupation, ethnicity, marital status, educational level, number of people participated in committing of the offense(crime), if the person ever been in custody and how long, data on the act of the crime (in the case of series of crimes, only the most serious act is considered), data for the court decision on sanctions imposed and information about the duration of the procedure.

3.2 Classification system

3.4 Statistical concepts and definitions

"The term ""adult perpetrator of a crime" means the perpetrator of a crime which in time of committing the offense had reached the age of 18, and has committed the crime as: executor, accomplice, instigator or helper. The term ""defendant" means the adult person against whom the court has made: charge indictment or a private lawsuit against whom criminal proceedings by a court decision is final completed. The term ""convicted person" means an adult found guilty and against the prescribed criminal sanctions."

3.5 Statistical unit

Reporting units: Primary Courts. Units of observation are accused and convicted offenders.

3.6 Statistical population

Statistical population is all accused and convicted offenders.

11.1 Quality assurance

13.1 Overall accuracy

The survey methodology and the data collection method ensure good coverage and accuracy of the data.

13.2 | Sampling error

Not applicable (survey is with total coverage).

13.3 Non-sampling error

Coverage error: Full (100%) coverage is ensured. Data providers are reminded to fulfull their obligations on time. Processing errors: Rules for control and calculations for output data are implemented in the processing. Non-response errors: As full coverage is ensured, there are no non-response errors.

18 Statistical processing

18.1 Source data

"This statistical survey is with full coverage. The souce of data for ""Statistical survey on accused and convicted adult perpetrators against whom the criminal procedure is completed"" (SK.2) are the Primary Courts."

18.2 Frequency of data collection

Annually.

18.3 Data collection

"Data are collected monthly with statistical questionnaire ""Statistical survey on accused and convicted adult perpetrators against whom the criminal procedure is completed" (SK.2). The primary courts fulfilled the data and they are delivered to the SSO no later than 17.03.2024."

18.4 Data validation

Control of data is carried out in accordance with the established methodological rules and guidelines for control. Control of data is performed before and after the entry. For any deviations, the reporting units are contacted. Control is performed on the completed data as well, prior to their publication.

18.5 Data compilation

Editing: After verification and possible corrections in consultation with the reporting units, i.e. register offices, the received data from the primary courts, are entered in an application with on-line controls. Outputs tables are prepared according to pre-defined templates with tabulation conditions. Output tables are checked by comparing and analyzing the data before their publication.
